



Guidelines for Individual Members In Door County Association of Home & Community Education

The following guidelines have been developed in establishing individual membership.

The individual member:

- Will receive the current program book and newsletter (these will be mailed). Our county newsletter is the *Ripples* and will serve as the main source of organizational information.
- May attend any Door County Association for Home & Community Education educational program or activity. Any materials from an educational program may be picked up from the UW-Extension Office at the Door County Government Center -- they will not be mailed.
- Be responsible for acquiring educational materials at educational programs from the UW-Extension office. Dates and times for educational programs are printed in the program book.
- May attend County Association meetings. Individual members do have voting privileges.
- May serve on County committees. Club membership is, in general, an important experience for County Executive Board members and Committee Chairpersons.
- May attend WAHCE Annual Conference.
- May attend District meetings in accordance with District policies.
- May hold county, district and state office with same voting privileges granted to other officers.
- May contact County Executive Board through the County Chairperson.
- Pays county dues to County Treasurer each year by December 15th.
- Portion of dues goes to State Treasury \$5.00, District Treasury \$1.00, \$7.50 to County Association Treasury; and \$1.50 to Scholarship Fund.
