Door County 4-H Club Community Service Grants



The 4-H Executive Committee has allocated grant funds for clubs to use that would help them in planning and implementing community service projects. This funding allocation will be revisited each year; it is not certain if it will be offered each year.

Guidelines for clubs wishing to request grant funds:

1. The funds are to be used solely for community service projects. It can only be used to carry out or help a club fund a community service project, no other use will be allowed.
2. Each club is limited to 3 grant requests of \$100.00 each. If you don't use the entire amount this year, it will not carry over into next year. **The grants must be matched from your club. For example, if you request a grant of \$50, your club must also put \$50 toward the project.**
3. To request grant funds, representatives of the club must send a letter to the 4-H Executive Committee explaining the community service project and what the money will be used for.
4. Once your club has completed the project, the club should send representatives to an Executive Committee meeting to report on the outcomes of the community service project(s). It is recommended to bring a brief summary of income and expenses related to the project.

It is the hope of the Executive Committee that clubs will use these funds to help them carry out community service projects and are able to try new community service projects or expand on traditional ones.

If you have questions on the grants or the process, contact a member of the Executive Committee or the Extension Office.
